

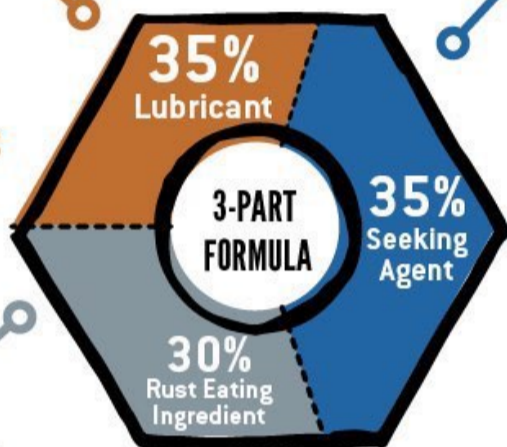

The Rust Seeker

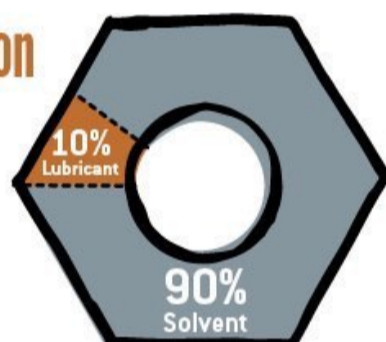

Free All vs. the competition

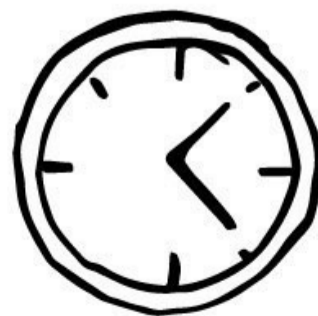
